Members Health Plan NJ is a self-insured, member owned MEWA (Multiple Employer Welfare Arrangement). Only employers from the sponsoring organizations are eligible to participate in the Plan. Currently, Members Health Plan NJ serves 3,900+ member companies/associations and covers more than 38,000 participants (employers, employees, and their families)

Members Health Plan NJ Sponsors serve as a valuable resource to not only the Health Plan but to the employer members that they serve. Each sponsor is unique in the services and capabilities that they provide to their employer members. Their value reaches far beyond the Health Plan. Each Sponsor has representation on the Health Plan Board and can weigh in on the plan decisions that affect their members. A MEWA Health Plan is an alternative model, not like other Health Plans in New Jersey. In essence, all members have a voice in the decisions about the health plan.

It is not uncommon that employers are members of multiple sponsors as each sponsor is unique at their services and capabilities differ between them all.

SPONSORSHIP CRITERIA

As a reminder, effective **1/1/2020**, all **NEW** employer groups will be required to be a member of one of our sponsoring organizations. It is also important to remind your employers that payments to the below associations **MUST** be made by the employer, not a broker or other third party. If an employer is unable to make the payment, they will not be eligible for the Health Plan. Sponsor membership(s) are for one year and must be renewed annually.

Groups are eligible through their association with the IPA of North Jersey, Trinitas Hospital Medical Staff, Mountainside IPA, Northwest Physician Organization, Inc., The Medical & Dental Staff of Hackensack Meridian Health, CentraState Medical Center, and Vista IPA.

- The employer must be a member of their local IPA and or Associated Hospital (if there is one).

Groups are Eligible if they are members of the Medical Society of New Jersey (MSNJ) either as a physician or as a corporate partner.

- The employer must be an active Physician member of The Medical Society of New Jersey as well as their County Medical Society or
- The employer must be an active MSNJ Corporate Partner Member and they must continue to maintain their active membership in order to remain eligible for coverage

Groups are Eligible if they are members of the Employers Association of New Jersey (EANJ).

- The employer must be an active member of EANJ and they must continue to maintain their active membership in order to remain eligible for coverage

Groups are Eligible if they are members of BioNJ.

- The employer must be an active member of BioNJ, and they must continue to maintain their active membership in order to remain eligible for coverage

Groups are Eligible if they are members of New Jersey Chamber of Commerce (NJCC).

- The employer must be an active member of NJCC, and they must continue to maintain their active membership in order to remain eligible for coverage

Please note the affiliation designation of **Medical -Professional Services, Medical – Dental Provider, Greater Monmouth Chamber of Commerce, Howell Chamber of Commerce or Jackson Township Chamber of Commerce** are no longer eligible Affiliations under MHPNJ. Any employers with this current Affiliation will need to select a sponsoring association at time of next renewal beginning October 1, 2020 and thereafter.
